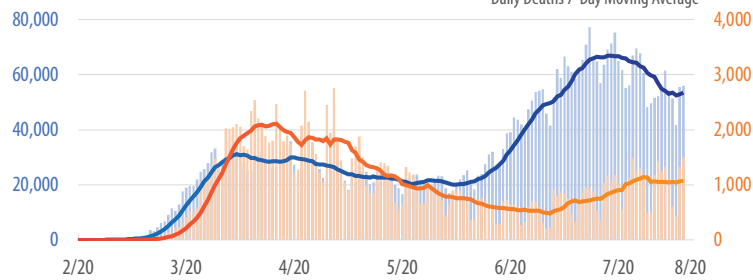


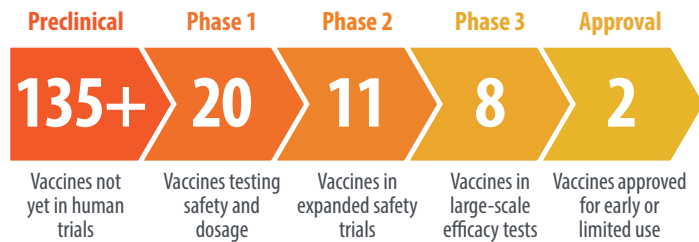

February 26, 2020 - August 12, 2020



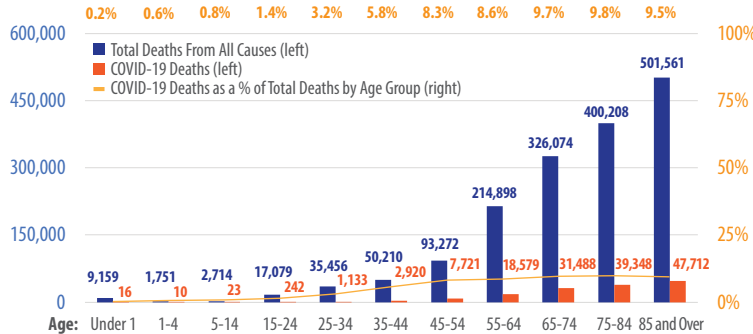

Total Deaths and COVID-19 Deaths in the U.S. by Age Group

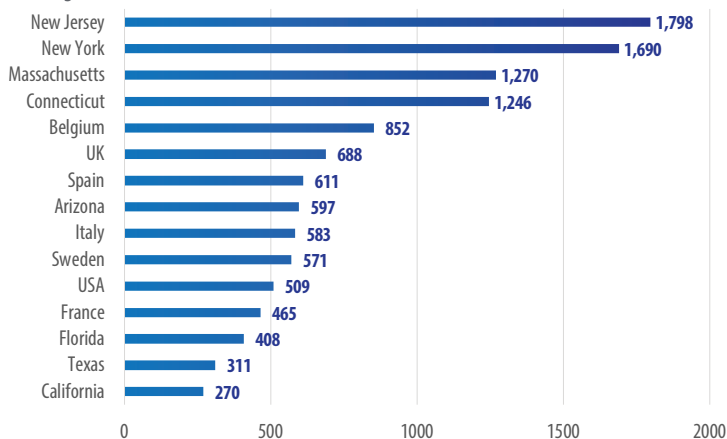
February 1, 2020 - August 8, 2020

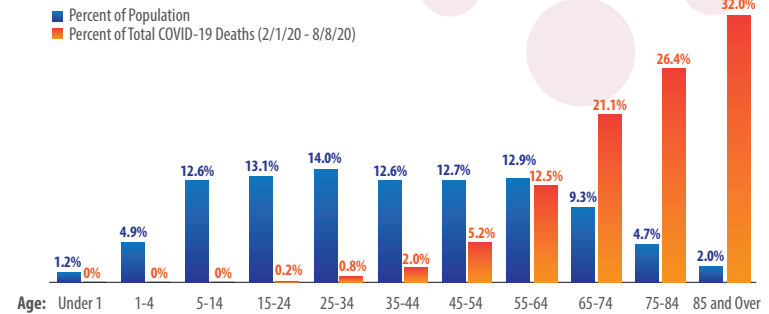

Suspected drug overdoses rose by 18% in March, 29% in April and 42% in May compared to the same months last year. Analysis of state and local mortality data showed that **drug-related deaths have increased ~13%** so far this year compared to last year.¹

Deaths by Age vs. Share of Population in the U.S.

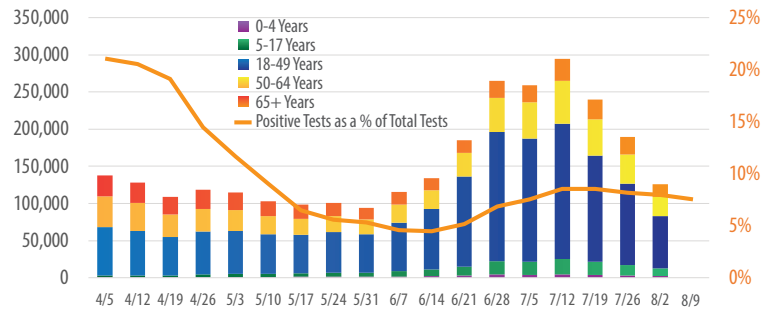

Weeks ending April 5, 2020 - August 2, 2020

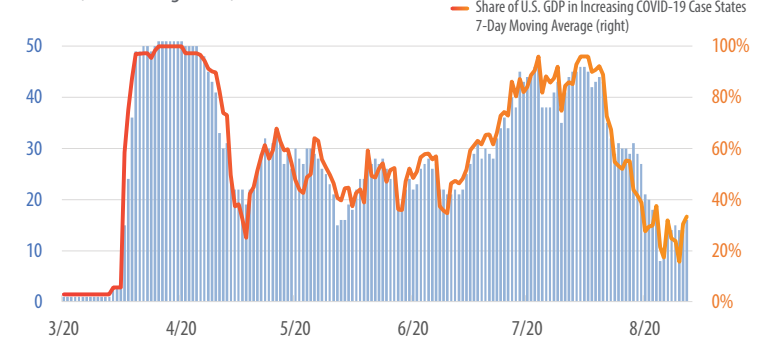

Through August 12, 2020, **daily reported new positive cases on a 7-day moving average for TX, AZ, CA and FL combined are down 30.3%** from the July 18, 2020 peak of 33,526.²
